The Spirit of Motherhood

Introduction:

- A. Motherhood is an awesome task, a joyful privilege, an eternally serious responsibility.
- B. But motherhood is *not* the greatest good, highest calling, or ultimate goal of the Christian woman.
 - 1. The greatest good, highest calling, and ultimate goal is conformity to Christ (*Rom.* 8:26-30).
 - 2. Almighty God is the Creator (*Isa.* 66:1-2) of masculinity and femininity, of motherhood (*Isa.* 66:10-13: 49:15-16) and fatherhood.
 - 3. As our Creator and Redeemer, he is looking for conformity to the perfect image of his Son.

- B. "Whoever does the will of my Father in heaven is my brother and sister and mother" (Matt. 12:50).

- D. Paul's ministry to the Thessalonian infants in Christ (1 Thess. 2:1-8)
 - 1. "We were gentle among you"
 - 2. "Like a nursing mother taking care of her own children"
 - 3. "Being affectionately desirous of you"
 - 4. "We were ready to share with you the gospel of God"
 - 5. "We were ready to share with you our own selves"
 - 6. "You had become very dear to us"
