Introduction:

- A. How can we navigate through those difficult periods in life when God seems silent and absent?
- B. This is one of the themes of *Psalm 22*, and it couldn't be clearer that Jesus had this psalm in mind when he hung on the cross, bearing his Father's wrath for the forgiveness of our sins.

v. 1: My God, why have you forsaken me?	v. 46: About the ninth hour Jesus cried out	
v. 7: All who see me mock me	v. 39: Those who passed by derided him	
v. 8: "He trusts in the LORD; let him deliver"	v. 43: "He trusts in God; let God deliver"	
v. 16: They have pierced my hands and feet	v. 35: When they had crucified him	
v. 18: They divide my garments and cast lots	v. 35: they divided his garments among them
