l	Should Be Our First Priority
	A. Prior to Jesus' discourse on discipleship, He spoke of another parable (Luke 14:16-24).
	1. In this parable, the man who prepares a feast is met with from many of those who were invited (14:16-20).
	2. The man others who are more willing to accept the invitation (14:21-23).
	3. As the parable concludes, Jesus makes a point about those who made excuses—" of those men who were invited shall taste my supper" (14:24).
	B. Now, after this parable, Jesus makes further application to the "multitude"—and notice He does not the message just because there is a big audience (14:25-27)!
	His message is about the priority of!
	 i. It is a message for "anyone" who tries to follow Him! ii. It requires a person "," meaning "love less," even their own family in the ladder of priorities. iii. It implies not all who to be disciples, are truly disciples (14:26 and 14:27)!
	2. This discipleship means being as dedicated to Jesus as Jesus was to the cross—it means (14:27).
